

434th Field Artillery Brigade 2024 Adopt-A-Soldier Program

2024 Christmas Day Adopt-A-Soldier Information Paper

Summary: The 434th FA Brigade Chaplain coordinates a Sponsorship Program whereby AD, NG, Reserve, Retirees, and DA Civilian Families in the Fort Sill AO volunteer to host a "Battle Buddy Team" of 2 to 4 IET Soldiers on Christmas day. Trainees that do not travel home during Holiday Block Leave (HBL) are invited to be guests in the Sponsor's home for approx. 3-6 hours to enjoy holiday fellowship and the atmosphere of genuine Family support on Christmas.

- Sponsors will be briefed and pick up Soldiers at the BLDG 6143 Barracks: Building 6143,
 Edwards St. Fort Sill, OK at 1000 on 25 DEC 24. Sponsors must return Soldiers NLT 2000hrs.
- The 434TH FA BDE Commander may cancel the program on short notice (due to inclement weather, etc.) IOT protect the safety and well-being of the Soldiers and sponsoring Families.

Guidelines:

- 1. Sponsoring Family must be Active Duty / National Guard / Reserve, Government Civilian, Military Retiree and must provide all information requested on the sponsor application form.
- 2. 434th FA BDE, 428th FA BDE, 30th ADA BDE and the Ordnance Training Detachment OTD, (BCT/AIT) Cadre cannot sponsor Soldiers.
- 3. Sponsors may live on post or off post anywhere in the Lawton-Fort Sill or Elgin/Fletcher metro areas. The 434th Brigade Commander will approve any exceptions.
- 4. Trainees must be in Battle Buddy Teams of 2 to 4 Trainees, depending on gender mix.
- 5. Trainees will wear Operational Camouflage Pattern (OCPs) for the event.
- 6. Trainees are subject to all TRADOC Regulations for IET Soldiers, including the **prohibition of alcohol**, **tobacco**, **and driving of motorized and/or recreational vehicles**. Trainees will be thoroughly briefed on rules and appropriate conduct prior to departure with a Sponsor Family (see TRADOC Regulation 350-6 and Fort Sill Regulation 600-3).
- 7. Trainees are prohibited from accepting gifts in value over \$20.
- 8. Sponsors will be given an information brief by the 1-40th FA BN Stay Back Battery Chain of Command at the Barracks, **Building 6143**, **Edwards St. at 1000 on 25 DEC 24**.
- 9. By-name (and similar) requests will be accommodated when possible. Sponsorship of IET Soldiers is not guaranteed. Sponsorship will be based upon the number and availability of IET stay back Soldiers wishing to participate in the program.
